THE VERANDAH PROJECT

The much anticipated verandah project will be undertaken during the upcoming holiday break. In order that the entire project is completed during the break, kinder will be closed on Friday 26 June to allow for the removal of the existing shade structure.

WHAT IS ANAPHYLAXIS?

Anaphylaxis is the most severe form of allergic reaction and is potentially life threatening. It must be treated as a medical emergency, requiring immediate treatment and urgent medical attention.

Anaphylaxis is a generalised allergic reaction, which often involves more than one body system (e.g. skin, respiratory, gastro-intestinal, cardiovascular). A severe allergic reaction usually occurs within 20 minutes of exposure to the trigger and can rapidly become life threatening.

Common triggers of anaphylaxis include: Milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, sesame, fish, crustaceans and soy are the most common food triggers, which cause 90% of allergic reactions, however, any food can trigger anaphylaxis. It is important to understand that even trace amounts of food can cause a life-threatening reaction. Some extremely sensitive individuals can react to even the smell of a food (e.g.fish)

HAND WASHING

A reminder to please ensure that your child washes his or her hands before entering the kinder building to start their session.



NO DOUBLE PARKING

Please ensure that you do not double park in the kinder car park at drop off or pick up times. This is both illegal and very dangerous. Many thanks for your cooperation.

HOLD HANDS AND DON'T RUN!

Please remember to always hold your child's hand in the car park outside kinder and ensure that they do not run out onto the car park.
